## EXCITING NEWS: WE ARE LAUNCHING SENSORY NIGHTS AT MUSE!

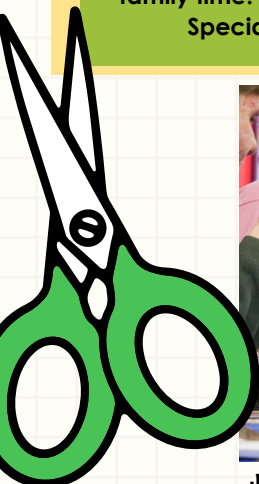
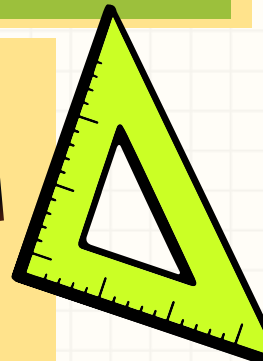
